This clause shall be read as through an open competitive Selection Process in accordance with the procedure set out herein." This change shall be considered as part of the RFP.

4. Refer point 4 of sub-clause 3.1.3 of clause 3 regarding CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION which says "Technical presentation by the firm highlighting understanding, approach and methodology, work plan and other aspects for the proposed project."

Issues such as deployment of Technical Experts, understanding of the RFP, methodology and quality of the WorkPlan shall be discussed during negotiations. A Technical Experts who did not score 70% (seventy per cent) marks as required under Clause 3.1.3 shall be replaced by the Applicant with a better candidate to the satisfaction of the Authority. In case the

Selected Applicant fails to reconfirm its commitment, the Authority reserves the right to designate the next ranked Applicant as the Selected Applicant and invite it for negotiations."

This clause shall be read as invited for negotiations. The negotiations shall generally not be for reducing the price of the proposal but will be for re-confirming the obligations of the Consultant under this RFP. Issues such as deployment of Technical Experts, understanding of the RFP, methodology and quality of the WorkPlan shall be discussed during negotiations. Technical Experts who are not satisfactory to the Authority shall be replaced by the Applicant with a better candidate to the satisfaction of the Authority. In case the Selected Applicant fails to reconfirm its commitment, the Authority reserves the right Selected Applicant and invite it for negotiations.". This change shall be considered as part of the RFP.

This clause shall be read as "The engagement duration of selected consultancy agency will be for one year and subjected to extension by two more years as required and deemed fit by the SACHIS on renewal every year based on satisfactory performance." This change shall be considered as part of the RFP.

11.Refer sub clause 5.3.2 of clause 3.3 (Payment Terms) of Schedule-1 on page 34 of RFP which says "In case any resource is absent for duration of more than 5 continuous working days without any valid reason which is not accepted to

SACHIS then the fees for the resource will be detected for the absent days. Per day cost will be derived on pro-rata basis for the man month rate for the resources as per financial proposal. There will be no penalties in case of the consultant deploying replacement resource (temporary) for the absent period the on 5 working days for any resource. Allowed paid leave for each position will be as per the leave policy of government of Uttar Pradesh."

This clause shall be read as "In case any resource is absent for duration of more than 5 continuous working days without any valid reason which is not accepted to SACHIS then the fees for the resource will be deducted for the absent days. Per day cost will be derived on pro-rata basis for the man month rate for the resources as per financial proposal. There will be no penalties in case of the consultant deploying replacement resource (temporary) for the absence period beyond 5 working days for any resource. Allowed paid leave for each position will be as per the leave policy of government of Uttar Pradesh." This change shall be considered as
